MP Mr. Bernie Grant was guest of honour at the official opening and dedication of the Tottenham church, West Green Road.

The history of the Tottenham congregation stretches back thirty years. In 1961 members of the Edmonton SDA church, living in the Tottenham area, having distributed tracts and sold copies of *Our Times* and *Good Health* journals, began conducting Bible studies. As a consequence, in 1964, the fast growth in membership in the Tottenham area necessitated the founding of a church. Accommodation was found in the Trades Hall building.

On 2 January 1965 this group was organized from a company into a church. The service was conducted by SEC president Pastor J. H. Bayliss, assisted by Pastor John Shaw and church elder Rogers.

The growing congregation soon found the Trades Hall building too cramped. For a time worship took place at Somerset School, Lordship Lane, N17. While this building was a considerable improvement there were many occasions when it was necessary to find alternative accommodation at short notice. This was why the congregation

moved to St. Marks Methodist Church on the Tottenham High Road.

This served the congregation for a number of years during which the church building fund gradually grew. Our prayers for a building of our own were finally answered when the Robins Mission came on the market. On Sabbath 12 December 1987 the Tottenham church gathered for the first time in their own building.

At our service of dedication in September, in addition to Bernie Grant MP we were pleased to welcome the mayor and other civic dignitaries. Mr. Grant spoke of the need for the church to give a moral lead in society against a backdrop of lawlessness and materialism. The main address was given by BUC president Pastor C. R. Perry. The dedicatory service was conducted by SEC president Pastor Don McFarlane.
