

4 Steps for Witnessing

Listen and care (Sympathize with them in their trials, their heartaches, and disappointments. This will open the way for you to help them. Speak to them of God's promises, pray with and for them, inspire them with hope" (**The Ministry of Healing 157-159**).

Affirm Our Similarities ("Agree with the people on every point where you can consistently do so. Let them see that you love their souls, and want to be in harmony with them so far as possible. If the love of Christ is revealed in all your efforts, you will be able to sow the seed of truth in some hearts; God will water the seed sown, and the truth will spring up and bear fruit to His glory" (**Evangelism 140**).

Share Differences Through Testimonies and Stories "As witnesses for Christ, we are to tell what we know, what we ourselves have seen and heard and felt. If we have been following Jesus step by step, we shall have something right to the point to tell concerning the way in which He has led us. We can tell how we have tested His promise, and found the promise true. We can bear witness to what we have known of the grace of Christ. This is the witness for which our Lord calls, and for want of which the world is perishing" (**Desire of Ages 340**).

Invite them to Experience Truth ("The secret of our success and power will be found in making direct, personal appeals to those who are interested, having unwavering reliance upon the Most High" (Pamphlet 118). "After the descent of the Holy Spirit, the disciples were so filled with love for Him and for those for whom He died, that hearts were melted by the words they spoke and the prayers they offered. They spoke in the power of the Spirit, and under the influence of that power, thousands were converted" (**Acts of the Apostles 22**).
